Pedro Santos, our Mission Partner from Tel Aviv is speaking The reading he has chosen is Isaiah 55. These notes are based on this reading.

Refer each question to what you remember of what Pedro said!

Isaiah ministered in Jerusalem in the Kingdom of Judah in the around 700 BC, a time when Judah was being threatened by Babylon. Half the Jewish people, the northern kingdom of Israel, had already been defeated and taken into exile in Babylon.

- 1. Read Isaiah 55 v.1-5. God is speaking to the people of Judah. What is he calling them to do- v1-3a? What kind of covenant (agreement) is God making with the people of Judah v.3b? Who do you think God is referring to in v.4 (they had to wait 700 years for this witness to appear!)? Who will God call through his "witness" v.4-5?
- 2. Read Isaiah 55 v.6-7. How do these verses sum up God's call to every generation? How do they relate to the Gospel?
- 3. Read Isaiah 55 v 8-13. What promises and encouragements do you find in these verses? Was there anything in what Pedro said that illustrates how these verses are being fulfilled? Can you see how any of these verses are being fulfilled today in the world, in the lives of those you know, or in your own life?
