- What part could you play in training children in the way of the Lord?

Read Deuteronomy 6:6-9

- How can fathers make talking about Gods teachings part of their everyday interaction with their children?
- How does the way that fathers act influence the effectiveness of their teaching?

Read Colossians 3:18-21

- Do you think if a husband loves his wife then it makes him a better father?
- What do you think the benefits might be of fathering as part of a parenting team alongside the children's mother?
