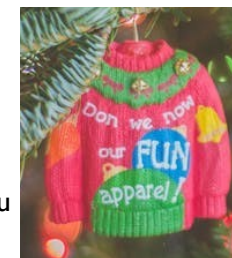
Cost £23. Sign up after the service and look at the menu options.
