

**Sermon Notes – Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> August**  
**“A Spirit filled life is a life well lived”**

***Continuing theme of A Spirit filled life***

Text/Reading: Acts 6v1-6

Title: “A Spirit filled life is a life well lived”

Opening Question:

If I asked you what you would like to have written on your gravestone, what would it be?

It is the last testimony to how you have lived your life!

We have been looking at A Spirit Filled life over the last few weeks. What does that mean?

Can others see we have a Spirit filled life?

4 Points:

In Galatians 5v25 Paul says, “If we live by the spirit, let us also walk by the spirit”

What does that actually mean?

We can examine this by looking at one of the New Testament Characters. Philip.

A brief examination of the life of Philip shows us four areas to consider.

[1] A Spirit filled life is a Servant Hearted life – Acts 6v1-6

[2] A Spirit filled life is a Mission Hearted life – Acts 8

[3] A Spirit filled life is an Obedient Hearted life – Acts 8

[4] A Spirit filled life is a Faithful Hearted life – Acts 21v8

Remember the opening Question, If I asked you what you would like to have written on your gravestone, what would it be?

Well, if I were to now ask you to write a text for Philips gravestone what would it be?

I would write, “Philip, A Spirit filled life, Walked by the Spirit, A life lived well”

Could this be written for you and me?
